ALL GUIDELINES apply from beginning of camp preparation until camp is closed.

!! Children 9 years of age or younger MUST have responsible adult staying with and supervising them. !!

Remember to Bring To Harmony Hill:

your Bible.....Cot.....Sheets.....Pillow.....Blanket or Quilt.....Towels.....Washrag.....
Toiletries (in plastic, not glass, containers).....Bag for Soiled Clothes.....Mosquito Repellant.....
Flashlight.....Pocket money for cold drinks, snacks, crafts, etc.....

The weather is usually very warm so light-weight fabrics are recommended, and you should bring a **sweater or jacket** and a **raincoat or poncho** for the unusual days.

We ask that if you plan to attend the singing school, and you will have **visitors** coming to the singing school at any time during the week, including the closing session, you make certain that **they know our guidelines and our dress code.** They are requested to **abide by the same guidelines.**
