Prior to the week following the second Sunday in June of each year, **Harmony Hill, a Primitive Baptist Foundation**, gathers a volunteer staff of Primitive Baptists to begin planning a singing school for our children and youth. In Primitive Baptist churches our worship services include a cappella singing and our hymnals are printed with shaped notes. Singing schools teach these skills for the purpose of glorifying God. Devoted to encouraging our youth in skillful a cappella singing and in Christian fellowship, we all, [children, youth, and adults alike], work together to provide a Godly atmosphere for learning .

Because we are not a traditional youth camp and have no paid employees, but have a most specific purpose of learning the rudiments and singing of shaped note music, our guidelines are especially critical. When we are joined by families of other denominations, they share in the responsibilities and the spirit and purpose for which we work, again to the glory of God.

**The 58<sup>th</sup> session of Harmony Hill Singing School will be held June 12<sup>th</sup> through 17<sup>th</sup>, 2011.** Registration will begin about 3 PM on Sunday. An evening meal will be served and a brief assembly will help us get acquainted (or reacquainted) about 7 PM. Classes will begin Monday following an 8 AM devotional and assembly.
